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RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS AND BID AMENDMENT#3

The Guam Waterworks Authority ("GWA") received the following questions from a potential bidder on February 17, 2017 relative to **GWA IFB No. 2017-12.** GWA's Answers ("A's") to the Questions ("Q's") as set forth below the perspective question. To the extent that GWA's answers amend the Bid, please deem as such.

Q#1:

1. Will someone be available to provide:

Risk information for each of the properties (for example: what material are each of the wells/tanks made out of?)

GWA Response: Please refer to Amendment #2

What precautionary measures are taken in the event of an oncoming typhoon for each of the properties?

GWA Response: SOP's are in place for such events. Since inception of GWA's insurance program in 2010, several major typhoons have passed through Guam and GWA has not made any claims on its policies.

2. Are we able to view the underground piping areas?

GWA's Response: The assets are underground, thus from a practical sense, they are not physically observable. However, additional information on those assets are provided below:
