Questions from July 5, 2018			
1.	Our company is currently preparing to bid GWA Bid Invitation # 2018-24. 50 TON Low Boy Trailer. There are several questions we have provided to GWA in regard to the 50-ton trailer specifications. One of the questioned specifications relates to "Suspension" Page 5. GWA has requested Hutch H9700TUS-49AC UN/MT SPRING and Equalizer, # 365 00 heavy duty 3 leaf spring.		
	Our company has requested that an "Industry Standard, Air Suspension" be considered an acceptable bid specification. This request has being declined by GWA procurement. Our company represents 2 major US trailer Manufacturers, both	GWA will consider an Air-Ride Suspension with automatic and manual controls, provided offeror can provide repair / replacement parts for such systems.	

manufacturers offer as a "current" trailer specification, "Air suspension", instead of spring suspension. Air suspension is viewed in the US trailer market as superior in performance to spring suspension. Past "spring suspension" specifications, have being reviewed and replaced with "air suspension" as an industry standard, due to better ride and handling, suspension adjustability, client preference. We assume this trailer is to transport GWA Heavy Equipment, a very standard application, for which air suspension is fully suitable.
