The Bid Opening scheduled for March 20, 2019 at 10:00am, will now be scheduled, for New Bid Opening on April 09, 2019 at 10:00am.</p>

		<p>EPA approved alternative product that is safe for handle and operate without the worries and hazards associated with chlorine gas.</p> <p>We look forward to a favorable response and would like to share with the people of Guam what the people of CNMI are currently experiencing – 5 sites where chlorine gas is removed and operating on our alternative/safe system. Data from these sites will most definitely be included in our bid document for comparable analysis.</p>
