

	1.	<p>I have a question regarding the Good Standing Affidavit. It states that I need to represent that I am “duly registered and in good standing under the laws of Guam or will be duly registered and in good standing under the laws of Guam.” I am a lawyer admitted to practice in the State of California, and in all the California District Courts and the Ninth Circuit (plus some out of state courts I have gotten admitted to over the years). I am not licensed to practice law in Guam. I am having our Admin look into what it would take to get me admitted to the United States District Court in Guam to see if I can do that without being admitted to practice law in Guam because the litigation at issue in the RFP would take place in federal, not state, court, under federal law. However, I don’t know what that entails and if it is possible to accomplish in time.</p> <p>So, can you please let me know what it means to be “duly registered and in good standing under the laws of Guam”? Do any of my current qualifications work and, if not, would it</p>	<p>For the purposes of this procurement, the attorney need not be “duly registered and in good standing under the laws of Guam”</p> <p>On page 21, under “GOOD STANDING AFFIDAVIT”, what is now stated has been amended to now read as:</p>
