MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- **A.** Must be at least 17 years old.
- **B.** Must go through an interview.
- **C.** Must consent to & pass criminal history background checks and a drug test.
- **D.** Must be a U.S. citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the U.S.
- E. Must have a valid U.S. Social Security Number.
- **F.** Must be able to serve 20 25 hours per week from Monday- Friday, and an additional four hours on Saturdays for a year.

NECESSARY SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

At a minimum, members must be high school graduates, GED recipients, working toward attaining a high school diploma or GED during their term of service. Members must agree to obtain either a diploma or GED to gain the education award.

NATURE OF WORK IN THIS CLASS:

Members will help implement an awareness and education campaign about our water and wastewater resources, promoting environmental stewardship awareness and practices focusing on the Fats, Oils and Grease (or FOG), Affordability and Water Conservation and Septic Tank Elimination programs.



<u>ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF SERVICE</u> (These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned.)

Participate in community engagement and impactful outreach throughout Guam schools and 19 village communities.

Provide environmental awareness resources through education, training and outreach water and wastewater resources and GWA's Fats-Oil-Grease (FOG), Affordability and Water Conservation Assessment Program and the Septic Tank Elimination programs.

Provide monthly disaster service training and build capacity for organizations through recruitment and volunteer management.

Conduct educational outreach events for residential water customers and the general public on the harmful effects of improper Fats, Oils and Grease disposal.

Participate in the development of outreach awareness materials and information tracking for residential water conservation and assessment techniques, including conservation practices, athome water audits, low-tech techniques for residents to identify water leaks.

Conduct outreach events to community members to provide information about the importance of the protection of the Northern Guam Lens Aquifer, surface water resources, and wastewater system.

Work with school communities to convey the importance of protecting Guam's water and wastewater resources

Hold environmental stewardship projects with island mayors and residents to promote valuable resources available in GWA's Fats-Oil-Grease (FOG), Affordability and Water Conservation Assessment Program and the Septic Tank Elimination programs.

Assist with or participate in service projects as requested by the Guam governor or island mayors and organizations.
