If granted approved by tomorrow, I wager that we should have enough time to get material here, schedule a jar test & wait for results, and put together a proposal in a timely fashion. Otherwise, if the extension is granted around the 3rd week of July, it we would still have only the same amount of time as we did when we first asked for the extension. 4.	<p>Could I get acknowledgment on the receipt of our request for pre-bid conference to get a better understanding of the bid requirement, jar test requirement, etc.?</p> <p>We can only start the process of getting material for jar test when we know how much to actually ship in. Therefore, the sooner we know, the sooner we can get started.</p>	<p>Refer to response #2</p> <p>Jar Testing is used to determine the amount of material that has to be ordered to execute a full-scale trial. Jar testing can be scheduled through the GWA Procurement office with concurrence with GWA WW Ops.</p>
