This addendum serves to revise the previously issued bid documents and/or provides additional information for informational purposes. In cases where the responses below result in modifications to the bid documents, please consider them as amendments to the original IFB 2024-20. The following responses address RFIs received from potential bidders on August 29th, 2024.

1.	What is the funding source?	GWA revenue
2.	Does this bid only allow USA manufactured excavators?	No
3.	The Bid calls for a 4-ton mini excavator but most manufactures have a 3.5 ton and jumps to 5 ton. Will a 3.5 ton be acceptable?	Minimum requirement is 4 Ton
4.	The bid specs call for metal tracks with polyurethane pads. Most manufacturers mini excavators only come with rubber tracks. Will an excavator with rubber tracks be acceptable?	Amendment for the following:  General Specification on Item 1.0. to read:  Metal or Rubber Tracks
5.	The bid calls for a Tier 3 engine, but as of January 2024 Guam no longer has EPA Tier 3 exemption. Will GWA amend the specification to EPA Teir 4?	GWA will accept Tier 3 with EPA certificate of conformity.
6.	Does GWA require AC on this excavator?	No
7.	The specs call for a .07 cm bucket, our Bucket for our 3.5 ton has a .11 cm is this acceptable?	Minimum requirement is 4 Ton
8.	The specs call for digging depths of 2650MM. Our excavator comes with a 3055mm digging depth is this acceptable?	Minimum requirement will be 2650 MM. Deeper digging depths acceptable.
9.	Can GWA clarify what it means by a Digging Height?	Measurement from ground to bucket tip fully extended upwards.

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10.	On item 1.0 price how will GWA evaluate a bidder who offers a 1-year warranty vs a bidder who offers a 3-year warranty? I recommend setting the	Amendment now to read: 7. Warranty and Service: All vendors shall provide a one (1) year manufacturer's warranty and shall act
	warranty period at a fixed time for 1 year, so the bidders are all bidding for the same thing.	as the manufacturer's agent in Guam for the purpose of processing any warranty claims or conducting warranty related repairs.
11.	For the trailer the specs call out for a hydraulic drop deck trailer. Can you clarify if the deck of the trailer must lay flat on the ground when loading?	Yes
