Is access needed for all device (e.g., DSL modem, router, switch, etc.)? Is GWA access required 24x7 or can we go through change management before providing access every time access is needed (this to ensure that access will be provided on a asneeded basis and to ensure proper authorization is received)? 	In regards to wireless access point, co-management is requested, request to gain access is acceptable, and would be as needed. Access is required 24x7 to allow the provider to troubleshoot and resolve issues as they arise, regardless of whether the connection is housed within a third-party facility. Delays in access can directly impact service restoration times, so real-time access is necessary to ensure continuity of operations. GWA will access any device in person only when required. ISP will be notified prior to GWA accessing device.

A security incident is an event that jeopardizes the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of information systems, or violates security policies, requiring immediate response and recovery actions. EX: If ISP has a ransomware event that would affect communications to Guam, we require ISP to report the incident to GWA within 24 hours of resolution. If the event directly effects GWA, immediate notification is requested by email for documentation and verbally for
		ease of confirmation.
16.	Referencing I. BID ITEMS, Page 8, Compliance with ISO 27001:2025 and ISO/IEC 15408: Please confirm if not having the ISO certification disqualify the ISP Vendor from bidding?	No, certification is not required, but compliance to the standard is required.
17.	Referencing I. BID ITEMS, Page 8, GWA Reserves the right to monitor compliance: Please confirm if this is a requirement for the ISO to be audited by GWA's internal or third- party audit team? Would a SOC3 report satisfy this requirement?	GWA continually audits the security of its internet facing devices, including any IP space assigned. GWA reserves the right to monitor its devices. We will not be monitoring ISP, just any IP space and/or devices that GWA uses. SOC 3 report is not required.
18.	Referencing Page 9, Section 1: Dual Circuit last mile: Please confirm since the requirement is 100mbps, does this mean there will be 2x 100mbps circuits ordered for Fadian location with diversity?	Only one 100Mbps circuit is required for the Fadian location. However, there is a preference for a dual circuit last mile configuration to provide redundancy. Bidders are encouraged to submit pricing proposals both with and without a static dual circuit last mile option to allow for evaluation of cost versus resiliency.
