Bid submissions must be received no later than Monday, December 23, 2024 at 5:00 p.m., Chamorro Standard Time (Guam time) unless revised via RFI or Bid Amendment. Submissions received after the closing time for receipt will not be considered.

	Question/Inquiry Received:	GWA RESPONSE:
1.	For clarification, has each site separate bid proposal? Or we gonna lump sum all the proposal for all sites?	Refer to Bid Amendment No. 1 which states, "This is NOT an all-or-none bid, meaning that the contract will be awarded to the bidder(s) who submit the lowest, most responsive, and responsible bid per site and to whom can fulfill all requirements outlined in this packet."
2.	Are we gonna follow all the typical details for materials attached in the contract, or are we gonna follow the existing materials in the site?	Contractors are to use the approved materials specified in "Section 32 31 13 Chain Link Fences and Gates" attached to the IFB.
3.	Can we proposed other materials if the existing materials is not available anymore in Guam?	Contractors may use materials based on the specifications attached to the IFB, titled "Section 32 31 13 Chain Link Fences and Gates"
4.	Clearing is not part of our scope right?	Page 6, Scope of Work, Item Letter K. states that "GWA Operations will be responsible for the clearing and disposing of the overgrown vegetation per site."
